
MATTHEW 21:1-11

Jesus was traveling with His disciples to Jerusalem. As He came to the Mount of Olives outside a village called Bethphage, Jesus instructed two of the disciples to go into the village where they would find a donkey tied with a colt. Jesus told the disciples to until the animals and bring them

to Him. He told the men that if anyone asked what they were doing, they should say that the Lord needs

the animals.

This happened to fulfill a prophecy (word of God) that was written hundreds of years before. This prophecy said, "Look! Your King is



The disciples followed Jesus' instructions. They brought the donkey and the colt, put their robes on them, and Jesus sat on top of them.



The crowd replied, "This is Jesus from Nazareth of Galilee."





THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE




CONVERSATION

Crucifixion and Resurrection

MATTHEW 26:36-28:10

Jesus took His disciples to the garden of Gethsemane. He knew that He was about to die. The disciples fell asleep, but Jesus prayed, "Father, please let this pass from Me. Not My will but Your will be done." He woke the disciples and said, "Get up. My betrayer is coming."



Jesus was taken to the high priest, Calaphas, who accused Jesus of claiming to be God, a crime deserving death. The leaders mocked Jesus, and witnesses told lies about Him. The crowd beat Him.

Peter, one of Jesus' disciples, waited outside. "You were with Jesus," some people said. Three times Peter said that he did not know Jesus.

The leaders sent Jesus to Pilate, the governor. Pilate could not find that Jesus had done anything wrong, so Pilate offered the people a choice: set Jesus free or free Barabbas, a well-known criminal. The people cried to free Barabbas. When Pilate asked the crowd what to do with Jesus, they shouted, "Crucify Him!"

Pilate agreed to put Jesus to death. Soldiers beat Jesus, put a robe on Him, and placed a crown of sharp thorns on His head. They nailed Jesus to a cross. From noon until three in the afternoon, darkness covered the land. Jesus cried out to God before He died. Suddenly, there was an earthquake. One of the men near the cross said, "This man really was God's Son!"


Jesus was buried in a rich man's tomb. A stone was sealed in front of the tomb, and men stood guard so that no one could steal Jesus' body.

On the third day Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to the tomb. Suddenly, a strong earthquake shook, and an angel came down from heaven and rolled back the stone from the tomb. The angel said, "Don't be afraid. I know you are looking for Jesus. He is not here! He has risen, just as He promised."

As the women ran to tell the disciples the good news, they heard a man say, "Good morning." It was Jesus! The women knelt and worshiped Him. Jesus told them, "Don't be afraid. Go and tell the disciples to go to Galilee, and they will see Me there."





CONVERSATION

Thomas Believed

JOHN 20:19-31

Jesus is alive! On the same night His disciples heard that Jesus was alive, they gathered together in a secret place with the door securely locked. They were afraid of the people who had arrested and put Jesus to death.



Suddenly, Jesus was with them! "Peace be with you," Jesus said. He showed the disciples where His hands and side were hurt when He was on the cross. The disciples were very glad to see Jesus. Jesus explained that He was sending them to tell others. He promised to send the Holy Spirit. He told the disciples to forgive others.

Thomas, one of Jesus' disciples, was not with the group. When the other disciples told Thomas what had happened, he did not believe them. Thomas insisted, "If I don't see and feel the marks that the nails made in His hands and side, I will not believe it!"

Eight days later, the disciples were together, and this time Thomas was with them. The door was locked, but that did not stop Jesus from coming and standing with the disciples. "Peace be with you," Jesus said to them.

Then Jesus went to Thomas. "Put your finger on My hands and look at them. Put your hand into My side. Believe in Me!"

Thomas realized that it was all true. Jesus was alive! Jesus had died, but He rose again and was standing next to him. Thomas exclaimed, "My Lord and my God!"

Jesus said to Thomas, "You believe because you have seen Me for yourself. Blessed are those who have not seen and still believe."

Jesus did many other things when He appeared to His disciples after the resurrection. Jesus' disciple, John, wrote this Gospel so that many people may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Savior, who gives eternal life.
